

# TYPES OF FAMILY VIOLENCE



## Intimate Partner Violence

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Refers to violence or abuse in an intimate relationship between spouse or former spouse, in relation to the person and dating or co-habiting couples.

## Elder Abuse

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Refers to action or inaction towards the father, mother, father-in-law or mother-in-law in relation to the person, which puts the well-being or health of the elderly person at risk.



## Vulnerable Adult Abuse

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Refers to action or inaction which places the well-being or health of a person 18 years and above with physical or mental incapacity, disability or infirmity at risk as he/she is unable to protect himself/herself from abuse, self-neglect or neglect.

## Sibling Abuse

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Refers to violent behaviours or abuse of brother or sister of a person, affecting the physical, psychological, emotional well-being of a person.



## Child Abuse

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Refers to action or inaction to harm physical, emotional and/or psychological well-being of a child of a person, including adopted and step-child.
